

PRECISION RIFLE 2

Course Description: This course was designed to be your next step in long range marksmanship. Students will quickly gain experience, confidence and increase their skill level with long range shooting. Students will be presented with a wide variety of practical drills and exercises designed enhance your ability to utilize a precision rifle for target shooting, big game hunting, or rural home defense. Participants will leave with a foundation on which to build their shooting skills at extended distances.

Course content includes:

- Safety
- Precision weapon manipulation
- Telescopic sight theory—Advanced
- Angular units of measure—review
- Range finding—unknown distance
- Effects of weather, wind and mirage
- Record keeping (D.O.P.E.)
- Shooting positions and use of the sling
- Follow up shots
- Live Fire exercises (100-450 yds)



Ammunition required: 200 new factory match grade rounds

High Quality bolt gun (.308 caliber preferred, autos and other calibers permitted with prior approval), Sling, Belt, Clear wraparound ballistic eye protection, Ear protection, Rain gear, Firearm cleaning kit, Clothing appropriate for climate and conditions, Steno notebook or Logbook with pencil and pen. Water bottle or other hydration system, Ball Cap, Sunscreen, Shooting mat, Knee and elbow pads strongly recommended, Spotting scope / Binoculars (optional), Lunch. Ear and eye protection
